Meeting the demands of the future

Langmatz promotes internal advanced training programme as assembly specialists

Garmisch-Partenkirchen, 17 June 2019 – Learning for life and steadily improving your qualifications beyond vocational training is the mantra of our time. Doing so helps to secure your job and ensure you get better at it. Based on this approach, Langmatz intensively supports the internal continued education of experienced employees. “We are very interested in further developing our employees so that they can meet the demands of the future,” explains Angelika Schubert, Training Coordinator at Langmatz.

This spring, the Garmisch-Partenkirchen-based industrial company organised an in-house advanced training course as “assembly specialists” in cooperation with the Chamber of Industry and Commerce (IHK) Academy Weilheim. Eleven employees took part in the three-month long qualification. At a small ceremony with lunch, the Board of Management recently thanked the graduates of the training course for their commitment and presented them with their certificates.

Over twelve weekends speakers from the Chamber of Industry and Commerce (IHK) attended the Langmatz plant in Oberau on Friday afternoons and Saturday mornings to teach the subject matter. The participants received in-depth knowledge of technical communication, assembly technology, material science and business administration, as well as the training of auxiliary staff and cooperation within the company.

The majority of Langmatz products consist of many individual parts, which are assembled in the assembly departments to form a finished product. Assembly consists of all the work needed to produce a functional Langmatz product from in-house produced components, third-party produced (supplier parts) and purchased parts. “The qualification as an assembly specialist should enable our employees to plan, organise and carry out assembly

orders even better. All of them familiarised themselves very well with the comprehensive learning material, supported each other and successfully passed their exam at the end of the course,” Angelika Schubert summarises positively.
